For this project, you will work individually. Your job is to come up with a series of questions to interview your selected artist, then report your answers.

CRITERIA:

- **ARTIST** – choose from one of the following artists (each may be used only once):
 - Pablo Picasso
 - Leonardo da Vinci
 - Michelangelo
 - Andy Warhol
 - Jackson Pollock
 - Claude Monet
 - Andy Warhol
 - Henri Matisse
 - Edgar Degas
 - Georgia O'Keeffe
 - Wassily Kandinsky
 - Piet Mondrian
 - Paul Cezanne
 - Gustav Klimt
 - Rembrandt
 - Edouard Manet
 - Marc Chagall
 - Roy Lichtenstein
 - Alexander Calder
 - Norman Rockwell
 - Mary Cassatt
- **CONTENT** – plan out an interview for your artist:
 - Try to keep the interview entertaining. Come up with questions in addition to the typical, where were you born, hobbies, etc.
 - Include:
 - Year and place of birth, family, death.
 - What movement did your artist belong to?
 - What are they known for?
 - What are the artist's most significant works of art?
 - What important events happened in your artist's life?
 - Any other relevant information?
- **PRESENTATION** – report your findings:
 - Q&A
 - Type the questions as well as the artist's response to each question.
 - Length & Format
 - You should have a minimum of 25 questions and answers.
 - Be sure to make it clear which is the question and which is the answer.
- **SUBMISSION**
 - Submit on It's Learning under "Interview an Artist".
