Look around the room and see what objects are available.

Create different still life compositions using the found objects.

Think about creating a focal point: contrast, isolation, convergence, placement, the unusual.

What Principles of Design can be utilized: balance, movement, unity, emphasis, contrast.

Take 3-5 pictures of your different compositions. From those, choose your best photo for your drawing. Be sure you can see details, it has a range of light to dark values, and will translate well in to a drawing. Sometimes a great photo does not look good as a drawing.
