

WHAT MAKES GOOD ART?

In this exercise, you will learn to view and critique art, and determine what makes a piece successful or aesthetically pleasing.

- Get in groups of 2-3
- Create a PowerPoint of 10-12 slides including the following:
 - Minimum of 14 photos of art pieces
 - Description of each piece
 - Group critique of each piece
 - Ex. We like this piece because...
 - Or...we do not like this piece because or... it could be improved by...
 - Examples of each of the following
 - Drawing
 - Objective Painting
 - Non-Objective Painting
 - Figural Sculpture
 - Abstract Sculpture
 - Still life (objects)
 - Commercial
- Save the PowerPoint
